

TOWN OF ARRIBA
BOARD OF PUBLIC HEARING
Monday, February 10, 2020
Arriba Town Hall, 711 Front Street, Arriba, CO 80804

Call to Order Mayor Alex Flores called the hearing to order at 7:25. Roll call for the Arriba Town Board was read and those answering were Marilyn Lightsey, Carolyn Steinsiek and Bob Rush. Troy McCue, Leigh Anna Andersen and Courtney Dean were absent.

Public Audience included: Jay Spurling, Kayle Amen, Marie Daniel, Debbie Brooks, and Taylor Henderson.

Sewer Rate Increase Clerk Hart said the proposed sewer rate increase was \$5 to the in-town residential and \$5 to the out-of-town residential. This would increase the in town from \$31.50 to 35.50 and the out-of-town from \$55 to \$60. She estimated this would generate a revenue of \$8,000 annually. This increase would be effective March 1, 2020.

There was brief discussion on what the rate increase will need to be to finance the proposed improvements to the wastewater facility. According to Element the rates will need to be increased at least \$7 but more information is needed at this time.

Clerk Hart said she thought that the Town should increase the Rest Area's sewer rate. The Board told Clerk Hart to talk to someone at the state about a possible increase to their rates.

Adjournment Mayor Flores adjourned the hearing at 7:45pm.
