PUBLIC NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION March 7, 1939.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 51 of the Town of Arriba, Colorado, adopted and approved on the 6th day of February, A.D. 1939, PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBYGIVEN That a special election has been called to be held on Tuesday, the 7th day of March, A.D. 1939, between the hours of 7 o'clock A.M. and 7 o'clock P.M. at Kalish Hall, in said Town of Arriba. At said election there shall be submitted to the voters of the Town who are taxpayers under the law, the following question:

> Shall the Board of Trustees of the Town of Arriba, Colorado, for and on behalf of said Town, erect waterworks to be owned and operated by said Town?

At said election there shall be submitted to such qualified property electors of the Town as shall, in the year 1938 have paid a property tax therein, the followin question:

> Shall Ordinance No. 50 of the Town Of Arriba, Colorado, passed by the Board of Trustees of said Town on the 6th day of February, A. D. 1939, odopting a plan for the acquisition of waterworks to be owned and operated by said Town, and describing the property tombe acquired, the method of payment and the total oblications to be incurred, be opproved?

The polls will be opened from 7 o'clock R.M. to 7 o' clock p.m.

The ballots to be used in voting upon the questions above submitted shall be prepared and furnished by the Town Clerk to the Judges of election to be by them furnished to the voters, and the ballots on each question shall be deposited in seperate ballot boxes provided by the Town Clerk for such purposes.

The election shall be held and conducted, as nearly as may be, in the manner prescribed by law for elections of municipal officers.

The Judges of election will meet on Tuesday, the 28th day of February, A D. 1939, at Kalisch Hall, in said Town, between the hours of 9 o'clocka.m. and 6 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of registering persons who possess qualifications intitaling them to vote at said election, but whose names do not appear on the official registry list of said Town, and for the purpose of revising, correcting, completing the annual registry of voters, and for that purpose they are authorized to take from the office of the County Clerk of Lincoln County, Colorado, the last official registry of electors of said Town.
