AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF ARRIBA, COLORADO, WHO ARE TAX PAMERS UND UNDER THE LAW, AND OF SUCH QUALIFIED PROPERTY ELECTORS OF THE TOWN, OF ARRIBA, COLORADO, AS SHALL IN THE NEXT YEAR PRECEDING THE YEAR OF SAID ELECTION HAVE PAID A PRORERTY TAX THEREIN, AT WHICH THERE SHALL BE SUBMITTED THE QUESTION OF APPROVING THE ERECTION OF WATERWORKS TO BE OWNED AND OPERATED BY SAID TOWN, AND THE QUESTION OF APPROVING ORDINANCE NO*50, PASSED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF SAID TOWN ON THE 6th DAY OF FEBRUARY, A.D. 1939, WHICH ORDINANCE ADOPTS A PLAN FOR THE ACQUISITION OF SUCH PUBLIC UTILITY, DECRIBED THE PROPERTY TO BE ACQUIRED, THE METHOD OF PAYMENT AND THE TOTAL OBLICATIONS TO BESINCURRED.

WHEREAS, ThenBoard of Trustees of the Town of Arriba, Lincoln County, Colorado, deems it advisible and the best interests of said Town and its inhabitants to acquire a waterworks system to be owned and operated by the Town; and

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of February, A.D. 1939, said Board passed Ordinance No. 50, which ordinance adopted a plan for the acquisition of such public utility, describes the property to be acquired, the method of payment and the total oblication to be incurred; and

WHEREAS; it is necessary that the question of the erection of such works be submitted to the voters of said Town who are taxpayers under the law, and the question of approving such ordinance be submitted to such qualified property electors of said Town as shall in the next year preceding said election have paid a property tax therein.

THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ARRIBA, LINCOLN COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That a special election is hereby called and the same shall be held at Kalisch hall, in the Town of Arriba, Lincoln County, Colorado, on the 7th day of March,

A.D. 1939, between the hours of 7 o'clock A. M. and 7

o'clock P.M. on said day. Section(2) at Sand Clusters above the following are transported to the following are transported.

Shall the board of Trusrees of the Town of Arriba Colorado, for and on behalf of said Town, erect waterworks to be owned and operated by said Town?

Section 3. At said election there shall also be submitted to such qualified property electors of said Town as shall in the year 1938 have paid a property tax therein, the following question:

Shall Ordinance NO. 50 ofn the Town of Arriba, Colorado, passed by the Board of Trustees of said Town on the 6th day of February, A.D.1939, a adopted a lpan for the acquisition of waterworks

to be owned and operated by said Town, and describing the property to be acquired, the method of payment and the total obligations to be incurred, be approved?

Section 4. Said election shall be held and conducted as nearly as may be in the manner prescribed by law for an election of municipal officers.

Section 5. The ballots for said election shall be prepared and delivered to the judges of election by the Town Clerk. The judges of election shall deliver ballots to the voters severally qualified to vote on the question submitted There shall be a separate ballot box for ballots on each question submitted in which the voters shall deposit their b ballots after the same have been marked by them. Said ballots shall be in substantially the following form:

Section. 7. The vote cast at said election on the questions aforesaid shall be canvassed and returned, and the return made and the result declared in the same manner, and as nearly as may be, as provided by law for the canvass, return and the declaration of results of votes cast at an election of municipal officers.

Section 8. A notice of the time and place of said election shall be published in the newspaper of general circulation printed in the Town of Arriba, In the County of Lincoln and State of Colorado, at least fifteen days before such election, and also a copy of such notice shall be posted at the place of voting at least fifteen days before such election, announcing the time, place and object of the election, and the Clerk of said Town is hereby charged with the duty of effectuating this provision.

Section9. Such notice shall be in substantially the following form:

Section 10. This ordinance, after its adoption and approval, shall be published in full in a newspaper of general circulation published in the Town of Arriba, in its issue of February 10, 1939, and shall be recorded in a book kept for that purpose, shall be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and Town Clark, and shall take effect and be in force upon the expiration of five (5) days after publication.
