AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN EASEMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, OPERATING AND MAINTAINING A PIPELINE.

Be it Ordained By the Town Council of the Town of Arriba, Colorado:

l. The Town of Arriba is hereby authorized to enter into a perpetual easement with Theodore E. Black and Mary Ruth Black for the acquisition of a right-of-way and easement over and across the following described property, to-wit:

A tract of land 20 feet in depth along the east side of the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, Township 9 South, Range 53 West of the 6th P.M. and bound on the north by the south right-of-way line of College Avenue and bound on the south by the north right-of-way lineof Lincoln Avenue, and said tract being exclusive of and bound on the east by the west right-of-way line of the County road running along the east boundary of said Section 12.

2. That the purpose of said Ordinance is for the acquisition of an easement across lands to construct, operate, and maintain a water pipeline as a part of the municipal water-works.

PIPELINE EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 28 day of October, 1968, by and between THE TOWN OF ARRIBA, a municipal corporation, first party; and Theodore E. Black and Mary Ruth Black, second party:

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), cash in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the second part have this day bargained and sold by these presents dobargain, sell, convey, transfer, and deliver unto the party of the first part, a permanent easement and right-of-way, including the perpetual right to enter upon the real estate hereinafter described, at any time that it may see fit, and construct, maintain, and repair underground pipelines and/or

mains for the purpose of conveying water over, across, through, and under the lands hereinafter described, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches and/or trenches for the location of said pipelines and/or mains, and the further right to remove trees, bushes, undergrowth, and other obstructions interfering with the location, construction, and maintenance of said pipelines and/or mains.

The land affected by the grant of this easement and right of way is located in the County of Lincoln, and State of Colorado, and is more particularly described as follows:

A tract of land 20 feet in depth along the east side of the Northeast Quarter Section 12, Township 9 South, Range 53 West of the 6th P.M. and bound on the north by the south right-of-way line of College Avenue and bound on the south by the north right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenue, and said tract being exclusive of and bound on the east by the westright- of-way line of the County road running along the east boundary of said Section 12.

To have and to hold said easement and right of way unto first party and unto its successors and assigns forever.

The parties of the second part do hereby covenant and agree with the first party that they are lawfully seised amd possessed of the real estate above described, that they have a good and lawfull right to convey it, or any part thereof, that it is free from all encumbrances, and that they will forever warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of persons whomsoever.

As a part of the consideration for this grant, the parties of the second part do hereby release any and all claims for damages from whatsoever cause incidental to the exercise of the rights herein granted, except damages to growing crops.
