

TOWN OF ARRIBA
BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
Tuesday, June 28, 2022
Arriba Town Hall, 711 Front Street, Arriba, CO 80804

Call to Order Mayor Marilyn Lightsey called the meeting to order at 6:02. Trustees in attendance included Kayle Amen, Alex Flores, Troy McCue, and Bob Rush. Marie Daniel was absent.

Employee in attendance included Josie Hart.

Public Audience Jay Spurling, Ben VanderWerf, Marcella Flores, and Lincoln County Sergeant Erwin.

Approval of Agenda Trustee McCue moved to approve the Agenda as written. Trustee Smithburg seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Campground Development Clerk Hart explained that an old 1 and a ½ inch meter had been found on the campground connected to a 2 inch old steel water line that comes from under Colorado Ave and connects to the Town's water system on the east side of Hiller Street. The steel line seems to be in working order, Ben and Jay did not think it needs replaced for their needs.

Clerk Hart asked if the Board thought the old steel line should be replaced. The Board agreed that the line doesn't need replaced at this time.

Clerk Hart said that Richard Hopp, the Town's water and sewer license operator, strongly suggested having GMS look at the campground plans and how the Town's water and sewer systems will handle it. Clerk Hart said the cost for GMS to do this would be \$632. Ben VanderWerf said he would pay up to \$632 in engineering fees.

Clerk Hart asked if the Town was going to give the campground a 1 inch meter or a 2 inch meter. She said that at the last meeting Ben had asked for a 1 and ½ inch meter and said he would pay for the parts and meter needed. The Board agreed the campground could have a 2 inch meter. Ben said he would like to know the cost of the parts and meter.


Clerk Hart said the meter pit will most likely need to be updated. Jay Spurling said a tree would need to be cut down to do this.

There was discussion on the history of the campground. There was discussion on if the Town wells can handle this extra water usage. There was discussion on getting the out of town wells connected properly to the Town's drinking water system.

Adjournment Trustee Amen moved to adjourn the meeting. Trustee McCue seconded, and the motion passed unanimously. Mayor Flores adjourned the meeting at 6:45pm.
