

ORDINANCE NO. 9.

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING CERTAIN OFFENSES, AND PRESCRIBING
PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Arriba,
County of Lincoln, State of Colorado:

SECTION 1:- Any person who shall in any public place, within,
this town, immoderately, carelessly or recklessly ride or drive
any horse, mule or other animal, or shall immoderately, carelessly
or recklessly ride any bicycle, or shall be found engaged in break-
ing, training or speeding any horse or mule, or shall ride, drive
or lead through the streets of this town any vicious, wild or unr-
uly animal without having the same properly secured, or shall leave
any horse or other animal in any street, alley or public place in
this town, without first securely fastening the same to a suitable
post, metal weight or other proper fastening, upon conviction there-
of, shall be fined in a sum not exceeding fifty dollars and costs.

SECTION 2 :- Any person who shall lead, ride or drive any horse
or other animal, or shall ride any bicycle or tricycle along or upon

any sidewalk in the town, or along or upon any walk along the side
of any street commonly used by pedestrians as a sidewalk, whether
paved or not, or upon any walk within the town parks, upon convic-
tion thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars
nor more than twenty five dollars and costs.
