ORDINANCE NO. 133

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ARRIBA, COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF THE TOWN'S GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY AGENCY BOND IN THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$705,000; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE BOND PROCEEDS TO PAY THE PAY THE COSTS OF THE PROJECT, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT COSTS OF THE PROJECT, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT DEPLYED FROM PAYMENT OF THE BOND FROM THE REVENUE DERIVED FROM THE OPERATION OF THE TOWN'S WATER SYSTEM; MAKING CERTAIN COVENANTS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. W-2009-1 OF THE TOWN OF ARRIBA WATER ENTERPRISE PROVIDING FOR THE FORM, PAYMENT, AND OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION WITH THE BOND; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS AND DOCUMENTS IN **CONNECTION DECLARING** AN AND WITH BOND THE EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Arriba, Colorado (the "Town"), is a statutory town and political subdivision of the State of Colorado, duly organized and operating under the constitution and laws of the State and has created and is operating the Town of Arriba Water Enterprise as a water activity enterprise within the meaning of Title 37, Article 45.1, C.R.S. and Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Arriba Water Enterprise (the "Enterprise") has no authority to levy or collect or use in its operations taxes, whether sales taxes, use taxes or ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town is acting hereunder as the governing body of the Enterprise (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise is a government-owned business authorized to issue its own revenue bonds and receiving under 10% of annual revenue in grants from all Colorado state and local governments combined and it is hereby determined that the Enterprise is an enterprise within the meaning of Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Town, acting by and through the Enterprise, has heretofore determined and undertaken to acquire and develop certain properties and facilities for the collection, treatment, transmission, and disposition of water, which facilities are operated and maintained as part of the Water system of the Town and the Enterprise (collectively the "System"); and

WHEREAS, the Town is authorized by Title 37, Article 45.1, C.R.S., and Article X, Section 20, Colorado Constitution, to issue revenue bonds authorized by action of the Board Section 20, Colorado of the electors of the Town, such bonds to be issued in the manner provided without the approval of Title 31. C.R.S.: and in Part 4 of Article 35 of Title 31, C.R.S.; and

It was thereupon moved by Trustee <u>Trey Micky</u> and seconded by Trustee ed and adonted that the foregoing Ordinance, introduced at this meeting as aforesaid, be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance.
